

Reader's Column Rules for the Montreal Chapter Liaison Bulletin

1. Each writer can be published twice a year.
2. Your articles can have between 300 and 600 words. If an article exceeds 650 words it will be sent back to its author to be modified in order to stay under the 650 words limit.
3. Once texts are submitted to the Montreal Chapter, they can be modified and edited before they are published. They are also going to be translated.
4. A selection is going to be made amongst articles to be published in the Liaison Bulletin.
5. Unpublished articles can be uploaded on the Montreal Chapter Web site if they comply with the Liaison Bulletin's criteria but were not published due to a lack of space. Texts are going to be replaced every trimester as the Web site is updated.
6. In order to be published in the Liaison Bulletin or on the Montreal Chapter Web site, articles should be related to Multiple Sclerosis and give hope or inspire the readers.
7. An article received after the deadline cannot be published in the current Liaison Bulletin. It will only be evaluated for a possible publication in the next edition.
